- 3. Photo: Side view with saddle firmly girth-fastened (horse standing closed and looking straight ahead).
- 4. Photo: Side view of you on your horse.
- 5. Photo: Fingers fitting between the front pommel and withers (when you are sitting on it).

- 2. Are you the original owner?
- 3. What is your clothing size?
- 4. How tall are you?
- 5. Compared to your upper body, are your legs longer, shorter or about the same length as your upper body?
- 6. Does a hand's width fit between your buttocks and the rear pommel? Or is it several fingers?
- 7. How many fingers fit between the front pommel and the saddle when you are firmly strapped in?
- 8. How many fingers fit between the front pommel and the saddle when you are
- 9. How many fingers fit one on top of the other below the cantle in the cushion channel?
- 10. How old is your horse?
- 11. Has it had a foal?
- 12. Has it had any illnesses?
