You have just purchased a leather product from our company. Leather items are an expensive investment, and you expect them to last a long time.

However, this is only possible with regular and proper care.

With Saddler's 'TLC' and 'Preservative', cleaning becomes child's play, because you can seeand feel how these leather cleaners help and benefit your leather.

Start with Saddler's 'Total Leather Cleaner & Conditioner (TLC)'. Saddler's 'TLC' embodies the knowledge of eight generations of harness makers. 'TLC' quickly and easily cleans the leather and nourishes the natural oils contained in the leather. Saddler's 'TLC' does not contain petroleum, which makes leather dry and brittle. It does not attack the stitches and seams. Dirt and stains are removed. The cleaned leather is protected against most stains (e.g. water stains), becomes water-resistant and helps to prevent mould and mildew. Saddler's 'TLC' has a pleasant smell and does not leave an oily film.



Application: Apply Saddler's 'TLC' to a dry sponge.*

Do not dilute Saddler's 'TLC' with water.

Allow Saddler's 'TLC' to soak in briefly on a new product.

For old, neglected leather, you should leave Saddler's 'TLC' on overnight and reapply the next day.

Now reach for Saddler's 'Preservative', which has been around for ages. It should protect in all weather conditions: hot and cold, wet and dry. Harnesses should be quick, easy and effective to clean and retain the flexibility of the leather. Saddler's Preservative makes the leather soft and flexible and surrounds it with a protective coating.

Application: Spread Saddler's Preservative on the leather* with a cloth (e.g. tea towel). Use Saddler's Preservative sparingly, like hand cream. Too much will make the leather sticky and attract dirt.



Saddler's Preservative protects new leather from stains and weather and keeps it looking new for longer. Saddler's Preservative restores nutrients to used, old leather, making it more supple again without cracking. For old or heavily used leather, leave Saddler's Preservative on overnight and apply a new coat the next day.



For extremely neglected and dirty leather, we recommend using extremely fine steel wool and 'Saddler's TLC' to clean the dirty areas with light, circular movements. If the leather is affected by mould spores, you can kill them with white vinegar. You should then clean the leather with Saddler's TLC.

There are two types of rot: dry rot and wet rot. Both are chemical processes that begin inside the leather. You cannot stop or reverse this process. Therefore, protect your leather from the outset and you will enjoy it for a long time.

Info: Saddler's 'TLC' and 'Preservative' can also be used on all other genuine leather goods*.

* Please test Saddler's 'TLC' and 'Preservative' on an inconspicuous area before using them for the first time. Due to differences in leather quality and texture, as well as different dyeing methods, reactions (e.g. fading of the leather) may occur.
