

- 1. Measure the saddle: To do this, measure 4 fingers behind the shoulder over the horse's back using a flexible curve ruler or wire.
 - 2. Transfer the measurement to an A4 sheet.
 - 3. Place the sheet under the foil and determine the width.

Attention: Intermediate sizes (such as 29, 31, etc.) must be determined by eye. Saddles from width 27 to 42 are usually in stock and available for immediate delivery!
